The project was directed by Professor Conxita Lleó. Apart from my work in the research project, I was assistant professor at the Spanish Department in the Institute for Romance Languages at the University, where I taught some 17 seminars (both introductory and advanced) on many topics of Spanish and Portuguese. The introductory courses were taught in German; the advanced in Spanish and / or Portuguese. I am therefore familiar with the German nomenclature in the field.

In Hamburg I also conducted regular tasks as interpreter (*Dolmetscher*) for primary schools and some private firms, translating from Spanish and / or Portuguese into German, mostly.

In 2012 I was short-listed for the position as Professor in Ibero-Romance Languages at the University of Zurich, where I gave two talks (on 17<sup>th</sup> September of that year) as part of the selection procedure.
